NOTE: See attached for eligibility criteria. Applicants are required Official Scores as posted on FCA website. The intent of this program is to provide a measure of assistance that will cover a portion of the costs of participating at the FCA's National Competitions. The assistance thus provided is dependent on contributions to the 3D and FITA Funds and having an available balance to award. In the event there are not many applicants for either fund in a particular year, assistance to an individual athlete will not exceed 50% of the costs for registration, travel and accommodation at the Nationals. Should this occur, athlete may be requested to provide proof of costs. In the event that there is such large number of archers qualified for either the Target and Field Nationals or the 3D Nationals that the assistance from the FITA/3D fund would not be significant. AANB may contribute to the fund so that qualifying archers receive a minimum of the registration fee for the Nationals attended.

1) 3D/FITA FUND

Criteria for Financial Assistance for National Championships

AANB has established separate 3D and FITA funds and manages them in order to provide financial assistance to qualifying archers who wish to attend the Federation of Canadian Archer's (FCA) National Competitions. The following criteria must be met before an Athlete can be considered for funding.

1. Be an AANB member of good standing.
2. Be a permanent resident of New Brunswick
3. To be eligible for FITA or 3D funding, archers must achieve two qualifying scores. Qualifying scores must be shot at two officially registered shoots. Qualifying scores are determined annually by the AANB Executive and posted on AANB's web site.
4. Must attend the National Championship; archers under the age of sixteen (16) must be chaperoned.
5. Qualifying scores can include those from the previous year's Nationals and any other officially registered tournament shot up to the current nationals.
6. Archers must conduct themselves in proper fashion at all events. Inappropriate conduct may result in the withholding of funds by AANB.
7. It is the archer's responsibility to track and submit their qualifying scores, with copies of signed scorecards or to identify official scores published on the AANB or FCA websites.
8. To receive FITA/3D Fund assistance (apply only after the Nationals), archers must apply to the Treasurer of AANB with proof of qualifying scores and proof of attendance at the Nationals (copies of signed and witnessed score cards from the Nationals). All applications and proof must be made before August 30th of the year of the competition.

Break down of assistance will be as follows:

If only 1 archer applies and he/she is otherwise qualified, 50% of fund balance will be allotted. If only 2 archers apply and they are otherwise qualified, 75% of fund balance will be allotted. If only 3 or more archers apply and they are otherwise qualified, 90% of fund balance will be allotted.
